

# KEYS The following table offers you a quick description about the phone's keys:

KEY	Function
FUNCTION	Perform the action indicated in the bottom of the screen.
NAVEGATION	In standby mode, you can access the user-defined functions, in Menu mode, scroll through menu options.
CENTRAL BUTTON	In standby mode, press and hold the button to turn on the flashlight, In Menu mode, select the highlighted menu option or confirm an action.
CALL SIM 1	Open the list of recent calls or make a call to the displayed number. You can answer an incoming call.

CALL SIM 2	Open the list of recent calls or make a call to the displayed number. You can answer an incoming call.
CALL SIM 3	Open the list of recent calls or make a call to the displayed number. You can answer an incoming call.
HANG UP	Ends a call or reject an incoming call. Hold down for 3 seconds to turn on / off the phone.
01239	Enter numbers, text and / or special characters.
#	Hold down 3 seconds to change the sound profile to vibrate.



## PREPARING YOUR MOBILE PHONE

Get started setting up your mobile phone for its first use.

### INSTERT SIM AND BATTERY

When you subscribe to a cellular service, you will receive a Subscriber Identity Module (SIM) card, with subscription details, such as your personal identification number (PIN) and optional servies.

To install the SIM cards and battery,

Remove the battery cover.



Insert SIM cards Your phone has 3 SIM card slots to allow you use 3 SIM cards and switch between them.



- Place the SIM card in the phone with the gold-colored contacts facing down.
- · Without inserting a SIM card, you can use your phone's non-network services and some menus.

3. Insert the battery.



4. Replace the battery cover.

# INSERT A MEMORY CARD(OPTIONAL)

To store additional multimedia files, you must insert a memory card. Your phone accepts microSD<sup>M</sup> or microSDHC<sup>M</sup> memory cards up to 32 GB (depending on memory card manufacturer and type).

Formatting the memory card on a PC may cause incompatibility with your phone. Format the memory card only on the phone.

1. Remove the battery cover.



2. Unlock the memory card holder

- 3. Lift the memory card holder and insert a memory holder with the label side facing up.
- Close the memory card holder

# USING BASIC FUNCTIONS

### ON AND OFF

To turn your phone on,

- 1. Press and hold [ o ].
- 2. Enter your PIN and press < OK > (if necessary).

### ACCESS MENUS

To access your phone's menus,

- 1. In Idle mode, press the left soft key < Menu > to access Menu mode.
- 2. Use the Navigation key to scroll to a menu or option.
- 3. Press < Select>, < OK>, or the Confirm

4. Press <Back> to move up one level; Press [ to return to Idle mode.

## USING THE CAMERA

Learn the basics to capture and view photos.

- 3. Press the Confirm key to take a photo. The photo is saved automatically.
- 4. Press < Back> to take another photo (step 2).

### View taken photos

Press the left soft key then choose Photos to access to the photos gallery quickly.
