 - Only qualified personnel can install and repair the phone.


1.4 Accessories and batteries

2.1 How to install the battery

- ♦ Open the back cover.
- ♦ Insert the battery into the battery slot.
- Close the phone cover.

2.2 How to remove the battery

- ♦ Open the back cover.
- Remove the battery from the battery slot.

Note: We recommend first off and then remove the battery to avoid loss of data in mobile phones.

2.3 How to charge the battery

- Plug one end of the charger to the phone charging port, the other end into a household power outlet. Note: This machine can be connected to a computer USB port to charge.
- When charging the battery level indicator on the screen icon was dynamic display, until the battery is full up.

 $\ \, \diamondsuit \ \,$ After charging, disconnect the power, then unplug the charger, so that the charger no-load.

2.4 How to install & remove the SIM card

The Phone supports two SIM cards. Before doing the following, make sure the phone is turned off and no charging.

- ♦ Open the back cover, remove the battery.
- Make the golden contacts of the SIM card face down, Card gap facing the slot gap, and then put into it.
- Install the battery and close the battery cover.
- SIM card's removal and installation steps are in reverse.

3 IMF

This phone supports multiple languages input. The IME can be alternated by pressing the "switching" key in the edit interface. Then press the corresponding keys in the keyboard to input.

4 Make & receive calls

4.1 make a call

- Enter the phone number in the standby screen, press the dial key with the selected SIM card to make calls.
- ♦ When to input, press the right function key to delete the number.
- During the call press the end key to end the call.
 You can also choose from a number of direct contacts to

allocate:

- $\ensuremath{\diamondsuit}$ Press the right function key in the standby screen enter the phone
 - number screen, and press the navigation key to select to dial the number.
- Press dial key to call the selected number.

Directly in the call log can also call:

- In the idle screen press the dial button to enter the call log.
- Press the navigation up and down keys to select the number to dial
 - Pressing the dial keys will make the call.

4.2 Make an emergency call

Within the GSM system, you can make an emergency call. When making an emergency call, please do not arbitrarily terminate the call. Phone without a SIM card can still make emergency calls.

Enter the emergency number.

Press dial keys to make an emergency call.

Note: As with any mobile phone, due to the network coverage reasons or wireless signal transmission case, may not support the characteristics of the mobile phones, Some networks do not even support the 112 emergency call service. Thus, for particularly critical communications (eg medical emergencies), should not rely solely on mobile phones. Please check with your local network operator and reconcilitation.

4.3 International calls

In the idle screen press "+" key then in turn enter the country code, area code and telephone number.

Press dial key to make international calls.

Note: International dialing code of some networks is not "+" sign, please be discretion.

4.4 Answer the call

- If there have an incoming call, press the dial key to answer the phone, hang up the keys (press the Home key) to reject a call.
 - Press the hang up key (press the Home key) to end the call.

4.5 Adjust the volume

During the call you can press the left side external volume key to adjust the volume.

4.6 Talk hands-free

During the call you can touch the "hands-free" key directly to opened or closed hands-free.

4.7 Call waiting

Conference call feature requires opening Call Waiting, If the network supports call waiting and you start this feature, During a call when there are new calls you will hear the call waiting tone, you can answer or reject the new call. Enter the "call waiting" feature to enable

or disable call waiting.

4.8 Call options

In the state of calling, touch the left function key to enter the call option.

In call option, You are able to maintain / restore, end the call, establish a new call, visit call logs, calls records, SMS, sound recording, DTMF(dual-tone multifrequency) and other operations.

5 Dialer

Click to dial interface. Input number can choose 'all' 'send MMS' 'send SMS'.

Click on the options can choose:1, Call 2, save to phonebook 3,

Dialer search

6 Messaging

6.1 Write message Text message:

- Enter the interface of the message editing, input the message content, and touch the left function key to access the options menu;
- Select "Options" to enter the menu where you can select "Send, insert commonly used statement, insert contact information,save messages" and other options
- $\ensuremath{\diamondsuit}$ Select "Send" or touch the OK key to enter the number inputting interface:
 - Input number: input the recipient number directly;
 - Add from Phonebook: enter the phonebook to select recipients.

Enter the recipient number and then touch the OK button to send text messages.

Multimedia message:

- ♦ Only when the network operator support, you can use this feature. And only the phone with compatible multimedia message features can receive and display properly.
- Enter the edit screen, press the left function button to enter the option menu.
- Able to choose "send", "add to", "add cc", "add bcc", "edit subject", "edit content", "preview", "save".

6.2 Inbox

- ♦ Inbox storage and manage the received messages.
- Into the inbox, touch screen option, open to view information.
- ♦ Inbox list interface according to options can be "view" "reply by sms" "reply by mms" "call sender" "forward" "delete" "delete all"

"delete several" operation.

6.3 Drafts

 \diamondsuit When edit a sms which saved as a draft message can be for viewing and management, operation in this feature , please refer to the Inbox.

6.4 Outbox

Outbox storage and manage the messages being sent and failed being sent. Please refer to the Inbox.

6.5 Sent items

Sent messages storage and manage the messages sent and stored. Please refer to the Inbox.

6.6 Broadcast messages

automatically be displayed in the standby screen, you can direct press the hang-up key cleared. For details, please consulting operator.

6.7 Templates

♦The phone presets numbers of the unit commonly used phrases, you can edit, remove, or take the phrase as the content of messages.

- 6.8 Messages settings
- 6.8.1 Text message
- **♦SIM**
- Profile settings: setting the number of the SMS center
- Validity period: setting SMS validity period
- Message type: setting the type of SMS
- Delivery report: setting the switch of SMS report
- Reply path: setting the switch of reply path
- Preferred connection: setting a preferred connection of the SMS

- Voice Mail server: Each SIM card can be set two voice mail number in the settings, press the "1"key for a longtime to make available to listen to dial voice mail number voice messages. This function should be supported by the network operator.
- ♦ Memory status: The memory status of SIM card and the phone are visible.
- $\ \ \, \ \ \, \ \ \, \ \ \,$ Text msg.counter: You can view the SIM card receiving and sending information quantity.
- Preferred storage: setting the preferred position of the storage of SMS.

6.8.2 Multimedia message

Data account: setting data account

Common setting: able to check and set the status of "sending", "retrieval", "preferred storage", "memory status"

6.8.3 Service message

Setting the switch of availability to receive the service message.

6.9 SMS Backup

- **♦ SMS Backup:** Backup all mail information in.
- ♦ View Backup: To view the backup information.

6.10 Schedule SMS

♦ Edit time, contacts and information content, time to automatically send the information to the edit contacts.

6 11 Blocklist

♦ Set SMS blocklist, block list number message will be shielded.

7 Phonebook

This feature can view and manage the telephone number information in the machine and in the SIM card.

7.1 Contacts List

- ♦ Contacts list is displayed by default for all phonebook records in mobile phone and SIM card., you can press "options" to enter the menu, then select "Contacts Settings -> preferred storage location" to re-set the display of the phone book.
 - ♦ In the list interface you can do the following:
- Select "add new contact", you can add a contact to a mobile phone or SIM card;

- Sliding touch screen or press the side key view records:
- You can search bar in the input alphabet quickly find contact;
- The selected contact can click touch screen option call or send a message; $% \begin{center} \end{center} \begin{center} \end{center}$
 - Select the options can perform the corresponding function;
 - Can establish a group, add contacts to the group.

7.2 Options menu

- In the Contacts Options menu you can do the following:
- ♦ View: check the detail of the current contact number.
- ♦ Sending text message: Sending messages to the current number.
- ♦ Sending multimedia message: Sending multimedia message to the current number.
 - ♦ Call: Dial the current number; or make an IP phone call.
 - ♦ Edit: Edit the detail of the current number.

- ♦ Delete: delete the current number
- ♦ Copy: Copy the current number.
- ♦ Move: Move the current number.
- ♦ Add to blocklist: Add the current number to the blacklist.
- ♦ Mark several: select the current or multiple contacts.
- ♦ Phonebook settings: Able to take operations below:
 - 1. Preferred storage: Choose the preferred position of storage.
 - 2. Speed dial: Turn on "speed dial" and set the number. Speed dial is available by pressing the corresponding key in the standby interface for a longtime.
 - 3. Extra number: Owner numbers, fixed dial may be set.
 - 4. Memory status: Memory status of SIM card and the phone can be checked
 - **5.** Copy contacts: The numbers can be copied to SIM card from the phone or to the phone from SIM card.

- **6.** Move contacts: The numbers can be moved to SIM card from the phone or to the phone from SIM card.
- 7, Delete all contacts: All numbers in the phone or in SIM card can be deleted.

8 Call logs

8.1 All calls

This function records the number or name recently dialed, missed and received. The options that can be chosen are "view", "call", "send text message", "send multimedia message", "save to phonebook", "add to blocklist", "edit before call", "delete", "advanced".

8.2 Dialed calls

This function records the number or name recently called. for Operations please reference Missed calls.

8.3 Missed calls

This function records the number or name recently missed. for Operattions please reference Missed calls.

8.4 Received calls

This function records the number or name recently received. for Operattions please reference Missed calls.

9 Calendar

- Into the calendar can view the date, can touch screen switch to a different date.
- Press the "options" to enter menu, You can view, view all, add event, delete event, jump to date, go to today, go to weekly view, start of week operation.

10 Camcorder

- ♦ Into the camera, touch screen click pictures Icon is photographed.
- $\ensuremath{\diamondsuit}$ Touch screen click on the options menu, can carry out the following operations:
 - ◆ EV: Set the exposure compensation.
 - ◆ Switch to: Can choose photo album, video recorder.
 - ◆ Capture mode: Able to set "normal" or "continuous shot".
 - ◆ Scene mode: Able to set "normal" or "night".
 - ◆ Image size: The image size can be set as "wallpaper", "VGA", "1.3 MP"
 - ◆ Flash: Flash can be set to off, force on.
 - ◆ Self-timer: Can choose to delay 5S or 10S...
 - White balance: Auto, daylight, tungsten, fluorescent, cloudy, incandescent.

- ◆ Effects: Normal, grayscale, sepia, sepia green, sepia blue, color invert.
- ◆ Adv.settings: For setting and operation to Storage, image qualities, shutter sound, anti-flicker, restore default.
- ♦ Into the camera, touch screen click on the camera icon.
- Touch screen click on the options menu, can carry out the following operations:
 - ◆ EV: Set the exposure compensation.
 - ◆ Switch to: Can choose video player, camera.
 - ◆ Scene Mode: Able to set "normal" or "night".
 - ♦White Balance: Auto, Daylight, Tungsten, Fluorescent, Cloudy, Incandescent.
 - ◆ Effects: Normal, Sepia, Sepia green, Sepia blue, Color

invert.

- ◆Record Limit: Unlimted, 15s, 30s or 60s.
- ◆Adv.settings: For setting and operation to Storage, Video quality, Anti-flicker, Restore default.

11 Settings

11.1 Dual SIM settings

Able to choose "Dual SIM open", "Only SIM1 open" or "Only SIM2 open".

11.2 Phone settings

- ◆ Time and date: Set the time, date and local city and its format.
- ♦ Schedule power on/off: Set up automatic open/shutdown of the time and switch. Open the automatic shutdown function, when the time is out the phone will automatic turn on/off.

- **♦Language:** Set the language the phone displays.
- ♦International keyboards: Input method on the function set.
- **♦Widget manager:** Set the X gadget window display function and sorting.
- **♦Shortcut manager:** Setting a standby interface shortcut function .
- **♦Display:** Setting "Wallpaper" "Menu page transition" "Screen auto lock" and "show owner number".
- Flight mode: Setting the phone to be the common mode or the flight mode.
- **♦Misc.setting:** Set the backlight brightness and lighting time.
- 11.3 Network settings

Setting to choose the network by hands or automatically.

11.4 Security settings

- ♦ SIM card security: This function can open or close the password lock. PIN number need to be input to power on the phone after it being locked. Remarks: SIM card would be locked after 3 times mistaking the PIN number, and then PUK number is necessary to unlock it.
- ♦ Phone security: Open this function, when boot you need to input password, the default password is 1234.
- ◆Data protection: Set the Data protection.
- 11.5 Notification settings

Set the messaging, call logs, downloads notification mode.

- 11.6 Call settings
- 11.6.1 SIM call settings
 - **♦Call waiting:** Set the status to be activated, deactivated, query

- status. Note: This function depends on the network operator. Please ask the local network operator for more detail.
- ◆Call divert: The options are "Divert all voice calls", "Divert if unreachable", "Divert if no answer", "Divert if busy", "Divert all data calls", "Cancel all diverts". Note: This function depends on the network operator. Please ask the local network operator for more detail.
- ◆Call barring: The options are "All voice calls", "International voice calls", "International voice calls except to home", "All voice calls", "Voice calls when roaming", "Cancel all", "Change barring password". Note: This function depends on the network operator. Please ask the local network operator for more detail.

♦Line switching: Able to switch line 1 or line 2.

11.6.2 Advanced setting

- **♦Blocklist:** Able to open or close the blacklist and set the numbers of the blacklist.
- ♦ Auto radial: Able to open or close the function of auto radial. When it's on, the phone shall redial automatically after you failed dialing.
 - ◆Background sound: Set call background sound.
- **♦Call time reminder:** You will be reminded when the call time reaches the time set before if it's on.
- **♦Reject by SMS:** After it's on, you may choose to reject by SMS when being called.
- **Connect notice:** After it's on, reminding sound will be heard when making a call.
- ♦Answer mode: Able to set answer the call by pressing any key or

auto answer when headset mode.

11.7 Restore factory settings

This function will be used for some settings which need restore the default Settings. Choose the item and input factory password for confirmation (factory password is 1234), the related parameters will return to factory Settings.

12 Alarm

This feature can be set up 5 groups of alarm clock, set time to, mobile phone according to the set type of prompt prompt.

13 Image viewer

In [image viewer] interface, press the [option] can undertake the following function:

- ♦ View: Able to view the selected image.
- Image information: Review images for details.
- ❖ Browse style: Able to choose list style or matrix style.
- ♦ Send: Send the image by the means of Bluetooth or MMS.
- ◆Use as: Set the pictures selected as "home screen wallpaper" or "lock screen wallpaper".
- ♦ Rename: Change the name of the selected pictures.
- Delete: Delete the selected pictures.
- ♦ Sort by: Sort the images by there names, types, times or sizes.
- ♦ Mark several: Photo of mark, can be labeled photographs.
- ♦Storage: Set the default path of picture storage.

14 Calculator

This function can be a simple four operations add, subtract, multiply and divide.

15 File manager

File management features provide file management functions in the phone or in the T cards storage device . Enter file management, there will be the current storage device list.

- ◆ In the list, the phone and T card can be formated and all data will be deleted.
- ♦ Select a folder, click on the options can do the following:
 - ◆ Open: open the current file.
 - ◆ New folder: build a new folder in the current storage device.
 - ◆ Rename: rename the current file.

- ◆ **Delete**: delete the selected folders, this function for system folders is unavailable.
 - ◆Sort by: according to folder name, date, size, sorting, type.

16 Sound recorder

Enters the recording function, can touch screen select start, stop, pause, play and other functions.

According to the options new record, play, append, rename, delete,

list, settings, use as, send can be operation.

17 Connectivity

Connection management: You can view the progress of the download. ♦ Data accounts: Setting data account.

18 Tasks

This function can create task, task time will be according to the task set prompt.

19 FM radio

- The phone has FM Radio function for listening broadcast, but the function is available only with the earphone inserting.
- FM interface can touch screen intelligent handover and fine tuning, Click the menu can carry out the following operations:
- ♦ Channel List: For compiling channel name and rate.
- ♦ Manual Input: For inputting rate manually.
- ♦ Auto Search: For searching channels automatically and saving the

searched channels into Channel List.

- ♦ Settings: For setting radio conceirned parameters.
- ♦ Record: Showing the recorded sounds.
- ♦ File list: View, playback of the recorded audio files.

20 World clock

This function lets you view the world time, enter the options can set daylight-saving time switch.

21 SIM toolkit

In this function can be customized with some carriers applications and services, please consult the local operator.

22 Health

This machine is used for the user to provide health management.

23 Stopwatch

This machine is used for the user to provide a stopwatch.

24 Unit converter

The machine provides a converter unit for use by the user.

25 Electric torch

This machine is used for the user to provide a flashlight.

26 Audio player

Into the music play interface, can undertake the following operation:

- ◆Play / Pause
- ◆Stop playback
- - ◆Decrease volume
 - ◆Increase volume
- ◆Access list, The list of songs by up and down navigation keys to move the cursor, According to the options you can perform the following operations
 - 1. Play: The currently selected songs.
 - 2. Details: You can view the selected songs specific information.
 - 3、Refresh list: The song list refresh.
- 4. Settings: The list auto gen, repeat, shuffle, background play set.

27 Bluetooth

- 1. Power: Setting the power of Bluetooth.
- **2. Visibility:** Setting the visibility of Bluetooth. When it's off, other phones can't search this phone though it has opened Bluetooth.
- **3. My device:** Searching the devices which has turned on Bluetooth nearby.
- 4. Search audio device: Searching Bluetooth earphone nearby.
- 5. My name: The name shows on other phones when Bluetooth is on and the phone is searched.
- Advanced: Setting the audio path and the position of storage and check the Bluetooth address.

28 Browser

The internetwork is the application platform which wireless communication combine with with Internet ,it can make you get plentiful Internet information resources and electronic commerce application by phone.

Note:

- 1. Your Internet service provider may not support the certain functions, in order to guarantee the normal operation of the browser line, please confirm your SIM card has support the Internet service.
- when you browse the web,it will costs related flow fee, the expenses please enquiry local operators.

28.1 Homepage

The choice will be directly connected to home page which you set in advance or the default.

28.2 Bookmark

Choosing a bookmark can visit the website which was set by the bookmark. You can reserve the commonly used web site in the favorites. Specific operation is as follows:

Add new bookmark: choose to add new bookmark, preserve after enter a new bookmark address and name.

28.3 Recent pages
Record your visited web addresses before.

28.4 Setting

Able to set the homepage of the browser, configuration files, data account, browser setting, favorite, security.

29 Currency converter

This machine is used for the user to provide a currency converter.

30 Ebook reader

Ebooks whose formats are txt can be read. Note: Txt files should be stored under T card's Ebook menu or in the phone.

♦When entering the reader, the files stored in the phone or T card are list in the interface.
