◆ **Phone Display**

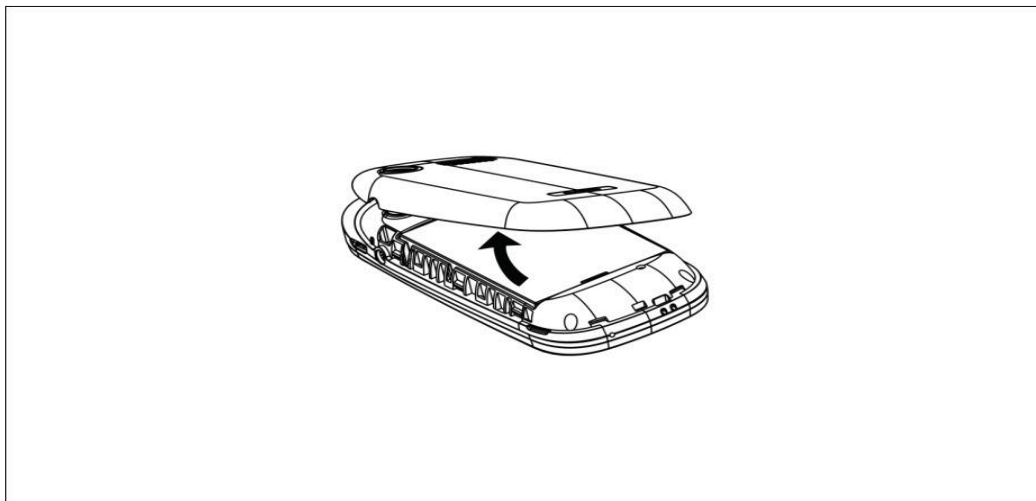


◆ **Key**

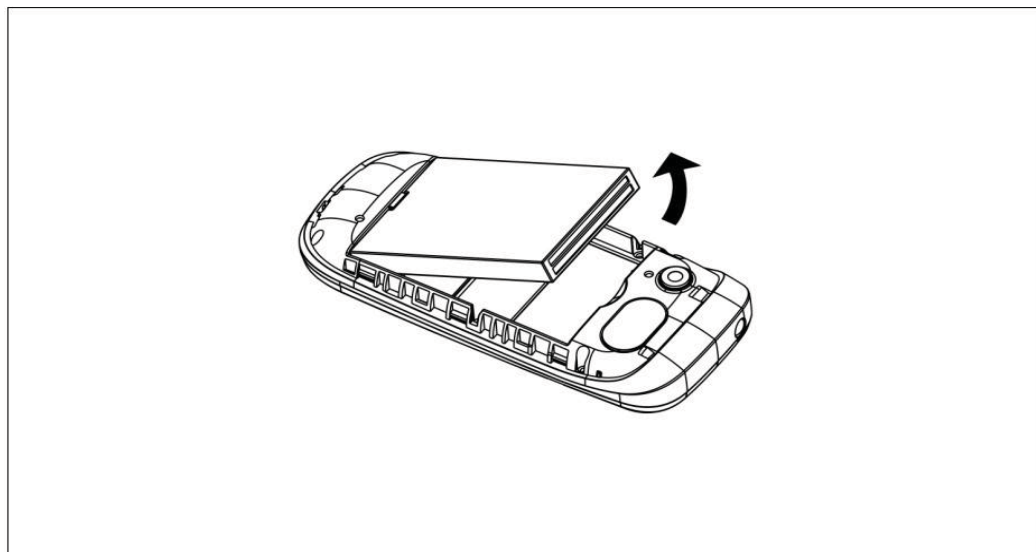
Key	Function
Call Key	Make or answer a call to Sim1 & Sim2. View Calls Logs in standby mode.
End/Power Key	Pressing and holding to turn the phone on/off. End a call or reject an incoming call. Return to the idle mode.
Left Soft Key	Menu key and OK key for functions
Right Soft Key	Access the Name list in idle mode. Return to the previous menu.
OK Key	Press to enter main menu in idle mode.

	After inputting numbers, press this key to do options.
Numeric key	Enter numbers, letters or characters. Select a submenu item labeled with the corresponding number. In idle mode, press and hold OK key to turn on/off torch light.
*	Press to toggle between *, +, (pause character) P, and (wait character) W. Press to enter symbol when editing text.
#	Press to switch input modes when entering text. Press and hold to change sound profiles to Silent Mode and General mode.

2.Battery disassembly & Battery assembly



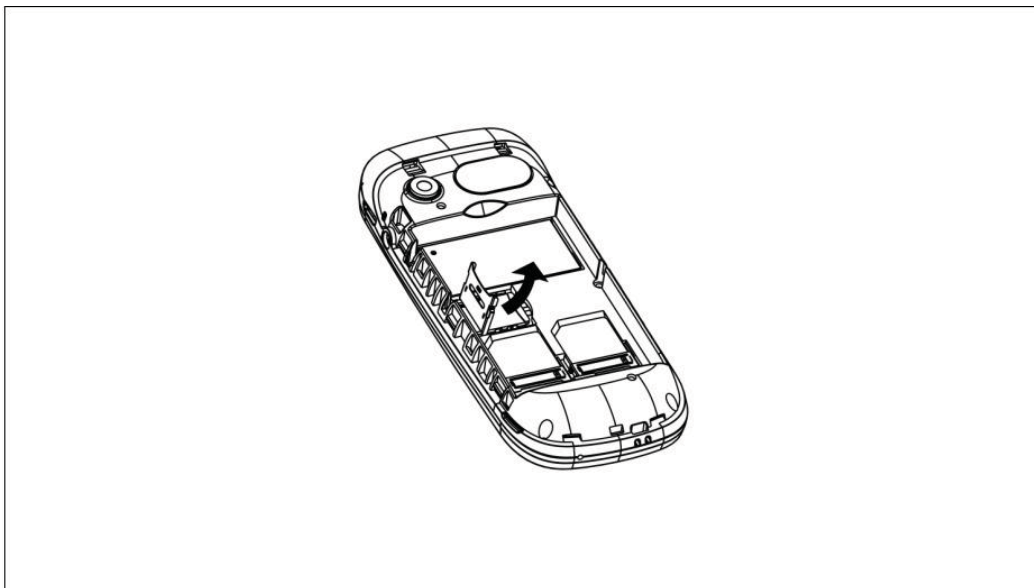
While removing battery, please bottom up the phones, remove the battery cover and pull the battery.

3.SIM card insertion

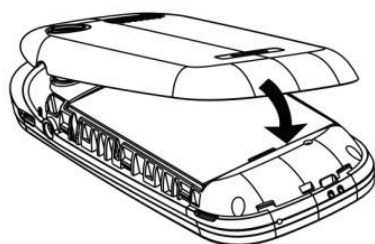


Put the SIM card into the card slot with copper sheet downward.

2.Menu

Call logs

All Calls: Check call logs for missed, dial, received calls and perform functions like save , delete view etc

Missed calls: Display the missed calls about the latest time and date, caller's number and calling times.

[Dialled calls] Display the dialed calls about the latest time and date, caller's number and calling times.

[Received Calls] Display the answered calls about the latest time and date, caller's number and calling times.

Press the right soft key to enter the options menu can be more than the number of call records in the following:

- **Delete:** choose to delete the current record
- **Save to Phonebook:** Save the record to phonebook
- **Call:** Call the current number.
- **Send text message:** send text messages to the current record
- **Edit:** on the current record for editing
- **Add to blacklist:** Add the current number to blacklist, after success, open the black list function.

Contacts

You have 2 phonebooks in this mobile phone: SIM card and the mobile.

- **View:** View the information of current record
 - **Add contact:** To add New Contact
 - **Call:** To dial the contact directly.
 - **Send text message:** send text messages to the current record
 - **Add to blacklist:** Add the current number to blacklist, after success, open the black list function.
 - **View:** To view contact info
 - **Edit:** Edit contact message
 - **Delete:** To delete the selected phonebook entry.
 - **Copy:** Provide two ways of copying: from SIM1/SIM2 card to mobile, and from mobile to SIM1/SIM2.
 - **Move:** Move current mobile number (from a phone to SIM, from SIM to phone)
 - **send contact:** To send contact via MMS/BT/to save in memory card
 - **Call groups:** Choose an contact number and add to contact group
 - ◆ **[Preferred storage]:** Choose the storage position for the
 - ◆ **[Memory status]:** Check the storage capacity of the SIM card and phonebook.

Multimedia

- **Video recorder:** you can be Switch to video record
- **Music:** To play the music
- **Video Player:** To play the recorded movie.
- **Image viewer:** To view the saved image.
- **FM radio:** To receive the FM broadcast.
- **Sound recorder:** To record the sound.

◆Audio path: to "Leave in phone" or "Forward to Bluetooth." Note: Due to this Bluetooth headset has the voice channel switching function, so when set to "remain in the mobile phone", click the multi-function Bluetooth headset button can also be connected to telephones, voice, but remain in the mobile phone side. Please refer to the specific operational guidelines of the Bluetooth headset, and recommended that users use standard headphones

◆Storage: to preserve choice in the mobile phone or memory card to receive the document

uMy address: Can be view the Bluetooth address.

Alarm

You can set 5 alarm times with this mobile. For each of them, you can set the alarm status to be open or not, set the alarm time and alarm frequency (once, daily or on several self-defined dates).

Calendar

To access the Calendar, press the left soft key. The first row displays year and month; the second row displays week; the middle part displays dates for a specific month; and the last row displays the two soft keys. In the calendar mode, view the previous week by pressing the up navigation key and the next week by pressing the down navigation key; View the previous day by pressing the left navigation key and the next day by pressing the right navigation key. The selected date is displayed in deep color.

4. Frequently Asked Questions and Troubleshooting

◆ Frequently Asked Questions

Cause and Solution

◆ Fail to turn on

Press the power on key for over 1 second.

Check if the battery is properly connected. Please remove and install it again, retry to turn on;

Check if battery is appropriately charged

◆ Fail to connect network

Weak signal. Please Try and move to a location with strong signal and try connecting to the network again;

Please ensure that you are not beyond the network coverage of service providers;

Please ensure you have a valid SIM card. Please contact your network provider for further information;

◆ SIM Card Error

Dirt on the metal surface of an SIM card. Use clean cloth to wipe the metal touch point on an SIM card.

The SIM card is not installed.

The SIM card is damaged. Please contact your network service provider.

◆ Fail to charge

Poor contact. Please check if the plug is connected well.

Charge in the environment below 40°C or above 55°C. Please change your charging environment.

The battery or charger is damaged. You need to replace it.

SAR (Specific Absorption Rate) Information

The highest SAR value for this mobile phone is <1.6 W/Kg, in accordance with the requirements of the ICNIRP, which recommended that the limit for exposure to radio waves is 1.6 watts/kilogram(W/kg) averaged

Safety precautions:

- Use a wireless hands-free system (Headphone, headset) with a low power Bluetooth emitter
- Make sure the cell phone has a low SAR
