Before Using

SIM

Before using your phone you must insert a valid SIM (Subscriber Identity Module) card. SIM card provide by the network provider.

Phone Unlock

In order to prevent illegal use, your phone can set the phone lock password protection. To use this function you must enter the phone lock password so that you can unlock the phone for the normal use state.

Enter the phone lock password, press the LSK to confirm. For example, if the phone lock password is set to 4321, then the following input: 4321.

SIM Unlock

In order to prevent illegal uses of your SIM use PIN (Personal Identification Number) password encryption protection. Use this function, if you have set the PIN password protection, every time you must enter the PIN password at boot time, so that you can unlock the SIM card and phone to normal use. Enter the PIN password, press the LSK to confirm. For example, if the PIN is set to 1234, then the following input: 1234. If there consecutive incorrect, your SIM will be network locked, the phone will ask for PUK password.

Contacts

The mobile phone can store up to 1000 telephone numbers .

Music

Use this function to play audio files. In audio player interface, you can press Up key or Down key to tune volume.

Camera

Use this function to take photos.

Messages

You can send and receive text message and Multimedia message. If the short message memory is full, a blinking message icon appears on the top of the screen. While entering the Messaging interface, you will see the following menu options: Write message, Inbox, Drafts, Outbox, Sent Messages, SMS templates, SMS settings, SMS Export and SMS Import.

You can record videos through this function.

Use this function to play video files.

Sound recorder

Use this function to record audio files. The phone supports amr format.

FM radio

User Profiles

Phone Settings
