## **SAR (Specific Absorption Rate)**

Your device conforms to the Indian guidelines for exposure to radio waves. The limits are given in terms of a unit referred to as the Specific Absorption Rate (SAR), which is a measure of the amount of radio frequency energy absorbed by the body when using a mobile phone. The SAR value as per the Indian guidelines standard is 1.6 watts per kg (Watt/kg), averaged over a 6 minutes period and taken over a volume containing a mass of 1 gram of human tissue. The highest SAR value of this device when tested is **0.585 Watt/kg. You can check it by dialing \*727# on your device.**

## GETTING STARTED

---

---

Please switch off your device before inserting or removing the battery/SIM card or memory card.

### **Installing SIM Card and Battery**

Your device is provided with two SIM slots for two different SIM cards. The SIM card inserted in the slot1 is called Master SIM, and the other one in the slot2 is known as Slave SIM.

- Remove the back cover of the device.
- Hold the device with the front facing downwards; pull the battery cover.

- Insert the SIM cards in the device.
- Attach the battery.
- Push the battery cover until it clicks into place.

### Installing Memory Card

Your device supports T-Flash card, which is a multimedia memory card used to multiply the memory of the device. The T-flash card is small and should be pulled out/installed carefully and prudently in order to avoid any kind of damage.

- Switch off your device.
- Remove the battery cover.
- Slide the T-Flash card into the slot.
- Attach the battery.
- Push the battery cover until it clicks into place.

### Charging the Battery

The device prompts a warning tone and message stating insufficient battery when the battery power of your device is low.

Please follow the instructions mentioned below to charge your device:

- Plug the connector of the charger into the jack of the device.
- Plug the charger into a standard AC wall outlet.

When  is shown on the screen, it indicates that there is not enough power and you should now charge your device. When charging is complete, the battery icon will stop flashing.

You must fully charge the battery before using the device for the first time. It is recommended to charge the battery for four hours before using the device for the first time.

If the device is turned on during charging, you can still make or answer calls, but this will consume battery power, thus will extend the charging time of the device.

### Turning the phone on

To turn the phone on, press and hold the **End key**. If you have already enabled the SIM Lock function then enter the PIN code (the 4 to 8 digit secret code of your SIM card). It is preconfigured and provided to you by your network operator or retailer. If you enter an incorrect PIN code 3 times in succession, your SIM card will be locked. To unlock it, you must obtain a code from your network operator. If the phone lock is enabled then you must enter the 4 to 8 digit phone lock code to unlock the handset. By default this code is 1122.

- Phone lock password is 1122.
- Anti theft password is 0000

## BASIC OPERATIONS

---

### To Make Calls

If the icon  /  appears on the screen, then you can make or answer calls. In order to make a call, please follow the steps mentioned below:

- Input the phone number (should affix the international/national/regional code or district code if necessary) and then select [M/S].
- You can select a contact number from the phonebook and call the contact person.



*The signal strength may influence the quality of connection.*

### To Dial International Number

Your device supports dialing the international emergency phone number, such as 112 and 911. With the device, you can dial an emergency call in any country or region under the normal situation regardless of SIM card inserted when the device is located within the coverage of the GSM network. Input the emergency phone number and press dial.

The device will select the main network automatically after powered on if it is located within the coverage of the main network. The device can use other network, called as roaming, if the device is not located within the coverage of the main network when the network operator protocol permits.

You can dial or answer a call when the symbol of the network operator appears on the screen.

### Answer/Reject an Incoming Call

- Press **Send Key** to receive the incoming call. You can use the earphone to answer the call when the generic headset is inserted in the device.
- Press **[End Key]** to reject an incoming call.



## Options During a Call

Press <Options> to use the following functions during the call:

- **Hold:** temporarily hold the current call.
- **End Single Call:** end the current call.
- **New Call:** access the dial keypad.
- **Phonebook:** access the Contacts menu.
- **Call History:** access the Call Logs menu.
- **Messages:** access the Messages menu.
- **Sound Recorder:** record the current call.
- **Mute:** on/off the mute mode.
- **DTMF:** select on/off for DTMF.

## MAIN MENU

---

Menu guides you to the various applications, features and utilities available in your device. In the idle mode, press menu key to access the Main Menu.



## CONTACTS

---

This menu refers to the directory wherein all the contacts are stored in an alphabetical order. You can view, edit, delete, send message and perform various other functions on each contact of your phonebook.

Select Phonebook.



### Add New Contact

- Go to Main Menu > Contacts > Add new contact
- Press Ok Key and select the desired storage

- After selecting the desired storage, press ok and enter the contact details


### Search Contact

- Input the initials of a name to be searched.
- Select a desired entry from the list.

## MESSAGES

---

Your device features, sending and receiving of SMS (Short Message Service) or MMS (Multimedia Message Service). Go to Main Menu and select Messages menu to create/read messages.



## **Write message**

You can create and send message to a particular contact using this sub-menu.

## **Inbox**

Inbox sub-menu enables you to view all the messages received on your Master/Slave SIM.

## **Drafts**

The created messages can be saved to drafts folder for future use. After selecting a message from the Drafts folder, select Options to edit/delete or send the saved message from the desired SIM.

## **Outbox**

The messages that are not sent successfully get stored in the Outbox folder.

## **Sent Messages**

All the messages that are sent successfully get stored in the Sent Messages.

## **Archive**

All the messages that are in inbox can move to archive.

## **Delete messages**

You can delete the messages from inbox, drafts, outbox, sent message, archive, also you can delete all the messages.

### **Broadcast Message**

This network service enables you to receive all kind of text messages, such as weather reports or transportation information. There are several networks who afford this service in this world. Please consult your network operator for more reference.

- Receive mode: Turn on or off the Cell Broadcast.
- Channel settings: You can choose Select, Add, Edit or Delete to receive the Broadcast information.
- Languages: Select the desired language to display the broadcast message.
- Read messages: Scroll the Up/Down Key to select the message.



*Your network operator decides whether the language is supported or not.*

### **Templates**

Your device is provided with some commonly used pre-defined messages. These messages can be edited and send instantly.

### **Message Settings**

You can view/change the SMS settings, such as profile, voicemail server, delivery report etc by accessing this sub-menu.

### **SMS backup**

This service allows you to export sent messages and import messages.

### **SMS Schedule**

This service allows you to send a message to a particular contact at a time pre-defined by you.

## **CALL LOGS**

---

Call Logs sub-menu lets you view the call details of missed, received & dialed call logs. In the standby mode, press menu key to access Menu > Call Logs to view the details and perform operations, such as View, Call, Send SMS, Add to blacklist, Delete etc.



### **Favorite**

The most frequently called contacts are saved to the favorite contact list, enabling you to access the contacts quickly and easily.

### **Missed Calls**

With this function, you can check the missed calls. Scroll the Up/Down keys to select a missed call. Press OK key to access missed call information, and perform operations, such as delete, save to phone book, call, edit and so on.

### **Dialed Calls**

With this function, you can check the dialed calls. Press OK key to access dialed call information, and perform operations, such as delete, save to phone book, call, edit and so on.

### **Received Calls**

With this function, you can check the received calls. Press OK key to access received call information, and perform operations, such as delete, save to phone book, call, edit and so on.

## SETTINGS

---

In the standby mode, press menu key to access Menu > Settings.



### Multi SIM Settings

You can choose one mode as per your desire.

### Pen Calibration

Click at any position on the screen and follow on screen instructions to start calibration. This operation allows the screen to respond more quickly and correctly.

## Phone Settings

### Time and Date

- Set Home City: Select the desired home city.
- Set Time / Date: Enter the current time and date.
- Set Format: Select a time and a date format.
- Update With Time Zone: It can be set to On or Off.
- Auto Update Time: It can be set to Off, First confirm or On.

### Auto Power On / Off

You can set the time for auto power on /off. Do turn the status on before using that function, and then the time.

Note: Please disable the Schedule Power On function before you board an airplane.

### Language

Your device supports English and Hindi language.

### Touch Vibrator

You can set on or off.

### Display

With this function you can configure the basic status of display characteristics including Wallpaper, Screen Saver, Power On Display, Power Off Display.

### Font Settings

You can choose font for your device as per your choice.

### Misc. Settings

LCD backlight: You can set the LCD backlight.

## Network Settings

Please contact the network operator for the following network service.

#### Master/Slave SIM Network settings

- **Network Selection:** You can choose Automatic or Manual to select the network (Auto is recommended). When you select Automatic, the device will make the preferential selection according to the network where the SIM card belongs. When you select Manual, you are required to select the same network as the registered network with the network operator by SIM card for your use.
- **Preferences:** Select the Preferred Networks. The default network is the network where the SIM card belongs.

### Call Settings:

#### Master/Slave SIM Call Settings

- **Call ID (Net work Service):** You can select Set By Network, Hide ID or Send ID. The default state is the Set By Network.
- **Call Waiting:** Activate, the network will notify you of a new incoming call while you have a call in progress (Net work Service).
- **Call Divert:** This network service allows you to divert your incoming calls to another number. For details, contact your service provider.
- **Call Barring:** Activate, this network service allows you to restrict incoming calls from your device. For details, contact your service provider.

#### Advance Settings

- **Blacklist:** You can set 20 numbers. When this Blacklist is enabled, you will not receive the calls from the numbers entered in the Blacklist.
- **White List:** When this white list is enabled, you can but receive the calls from the numbers entered in the white list. You can set 20 numbers for white list.
- **Auto Call Record:** select this option to record all calls automatically.
- **Auto redial:** On, the device will automatically redial the last called number after a while if you fail to connect to the number. The times for auto redial are up to 10 times. Press Abort to end Auto Redial.
- **Call Time Display:** You can set Call Time Display as On or Off. The call time will be displayed when set on.
- **Call time reminder:** This function prompts you to end the call in time to save the call cost. You can select Off, Single, or Periodic
- **Auto quick end:** You can set ON/ OFF, and set a time (1~9999s) as per your desire.
- **Connect Notice:** You can set on or off.
- **Answer mode**
- **Any Key:** Press any key to answer a call (Except of Call End Key and Right Soft Key)
- **Auto answer when headset mode:** In the headset mode, the device will Auto answer when there is an incoming call.

## **Restore Factory Settings**

Access Settings to select Restore Factory Settings, and press OK. All settings can be restored to factory settings with this function. The default password is 1122.


